This initiative began with a simple idea: health does not start in a doctor's office. It starts in the stability of a family's home, in the availability of nutritious meals, in the quality of local schools, and in the strength of the social networks around us. With that understanding, Aeroflow set out to invest in the broader factors that shape a person's well-being.



Today, Aeroflow partners with local organizations that are working to meet these needs every day, including efforts to build affordable housing, reduce food insecurity, support youth development, expand healthcare access, and improve pathways to education.

This commitment is reflected not only in financial support but in the actions of Aeroflow employees themselves. Every team member receives 16 hours of paid volunteer time each year to support the causes and communities closest to them, including many of those who work remotely across the country. This empowers employees to take part in the work of Aeroflow Cares in a personal and meaningful way, creating a culture of service that extends far beyond the workplace.

Bringing this commitment closer to home, Aeroflow Health stepped up to support western North Carolina communities impacted by Hurricane Helene and continues to support recovery efforts in the region today.

Aeroflow has pledged to donate more than \$5 million to community causes by 2029, a long-term investment that underscores Aeroflow's belief that healthier communities lead to healthier lives.




